This 2-year grant will reach more than 400 students through school programs and more than 7,000 through community events.
Independence Center	Northeast Region	\$299,373	As part of MFH's Healthy and Active Communities Initiative, this funding enables the organization to offer obesity prevention activities and programs, train area mental health professionals about obesity prevention, and implement worksite policies to promote active lifestyles and healthy eating.
Kirksville R-III School District	Northeast Region	\$106,072	More than 2,000 area students are learning about the effects of tobacco use and being encouraged to not use tobacco products through the Project Smokebusters program. This 2-year grant to the district is part of MFH's Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Initiative.
Knox County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$63,998	More than 550 Knox County School district students are participating in Project Smokebusters, a program that focuses on the benefits of smoke-free environments. This 2-year grant is part of MFH's Tobacco Prevention and Cessation Initiative.

Lewis County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$11,766	Funding is for salaries, computers and software in order to support the health department's early prenatal care program in northeast Missouri.
Mark Twain Area Counseling Center	Northeast Region	\$99,955	The 2-year basic support grant enables this northeast Missouri mental health center to purchase and upgrade needed computer equipment.
North East Community Action Corporation Family Planning	Northeast Region	\$88,765	This grant maintains existing family planning services and also provides for staff training and equipment purchases for this organization which serves northeast Missouri.
Preferred Family Healthcare, Inc.	Northeast Region	\$521,366	This two-year grant implements workplace-based tobacco cessation programs in 12 northeast Missouri counties: Adair, Clark, Knox, Lewis, Linn, Macon, Marion, Putnam, Schuyler, Scotland, Shelby and Sullivan.
Ralls County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$99,632	Funding through this 2-year basic support grant offsets salaries and supply costs for this northeast Missouri health department.
Scotland County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$93,387	This 2-year grant funds the purchase of safety seats for infants and toddlers, and replacement equipment, along with salary support for the northeast Missouri organization.
Scotland County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$175,797	Through MFH's Healthy & Active Communities Initiative, this 2-year grant funds a partnership with the Clark County Health Department to increase awareness of nutrition and healthy behaviors, develop physical activity challenges and education programs for families, and provide scholarships to fitness facilities.
Twin Pike Family YMCA	Northeast Region	\$100,000	This basic support grant covers operational costs of the northeast Missouri organization, which provides programs and services that focus on personal, spiritual, and physical development of individuals.

Pike County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$286,239	This 3-year project provides health education to approximately 500 persons with chronic disease and training health educators on the Stanford Chronic Disease Self-Management model. This is in an effort to reduce preventable hospitalizations.
Scotland County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$54,329	This 12-month grant updates equipment and supplies and expand clinical space in order to serve more women and children.
Shelby County Health Department	Northeast Region	\$312,151	This 3-year project provides women's health services to 1,440 women per year.
